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ABOUT THIS CATALOGUE

WHY HAVE WE PRODUCED THIS CATALOGUE IN THIS FORM?

At Revington TR we have seen many attempts at producing catalogues covering the TR range, some poor, some extremely good, some inadequate and some misleading.

We have felt that the cost of trying to include all our range of parts, standard and modified, for Road, Rally, Hillclimb, Sprint and Race, in our own fully illustrated catalogue, is prohibitive.

The compromise, which we hope you will find workable, is for you to use this Revington TR catalogue in conjunction with the original Triumph parts catalogue (or a reprint of it) relevant to your car or cars. If you do not have a Triumph parts catalogue, no problem, you can access them on our website www.revingtontr.com or if you wish to purchase a hardcopy, we sell exact reproductions of the original, and are extremely detailed. Also, the exploded views are sometimes useful. We also sell a CD containing the handbook workshop manual and parts book which is the most economical way of purchasing this information. These products are listed in Section 9.

WE HAVE MADE NO ATTEMPT TO INCLUDE OUR VAST RANGE OF STANDARD PARTS IN THIS CATALOGUE ONLY THOSE WHICH ARE SPECIAL OR ARE NOT WELL REPRESENTED IN THE ORIGINAL CATALOGUES ARE INCLUDED. STANDARD PARTS SHOULD BE IDENTIFIED AND ORDERED BY ORIGINAL PART NUMBER

ORIGINAL EQUIPMENT CATALOGUES

HOW IT WORKS

We believe that the original, Triumph parts catalogues are the definitive catalogues for adequately identifying standard parts and see no point in duplicating this work. We recognise all the original part numbers from these catalogues.

Many parts have been superseded over the years to parts that are common to many cars. This was particularly evident when Leyland had taken over almost all small and medium sized UK motorcar manufactures. Unipart were set up to rationalise all these separate manufacturersqspares inventories.

Therefore if you order a TR7 steering rack inner ball joint assembly, part number, UKC3934, you will be supplied with part number GSV1032 which is the same item now with a common part number for more than one application.

Where we supply alternative parts or kits instead of individual parts (carpet sets are a good example of this), these are listed in this Revington TR catalogue, usually using our own part number.

We have over the years produced a wealth of modifications to enhance the enjoyment of your TR, in addition we have tested many modifications offered by others, and if we have concluded that they are safe and useful, they are included in this Revington TR catalogue. Whist we still maintain this paper catalogue downloadable from our website, it is in the most part much superseded now by web based information.

Additionally, where we feel that the original parts book requires further explanation, we have offered information under the appropriate section.

WHAT YOU GET

This Revington TR catalogue should therefore not be viewed as a complete list of what we can offer, but as an addendum to your Triumph parts catalogue.

Our policy is one of continuous improvement of our service to our customers; there will therefore be a new product available by the time you read this. For this reason, please do not assume a part is not available, please ask!

PART NUMBERS

You will see that various styles of part numbers are used in this catalogue. These fall broadly into three categories.

1. Part numbers prefixed RTR. These are not surprisingly our own series of numbers, RTR standing for RevingtonTR. A four-digit number follows the prefix RTR where the first number usually identifies the section of this Revington TR catalogue where the parts belong. These numbers may also be suffixed with a variety of numbers or letters. The following are general rules but there are exceptions.

ABOUT REVINGTON TR

Revington TR started, as many businesses do, by growing out of a hobby.

Neil Revington has owned a TR2 registered TKR49 since 1970 when as an apprentice he bought the car for £70.00 and promptly spun it on ice, taking out all four corners! The car was rebuilt over the following two years using Dexion shelving and Ministry of Defence filing cabinets; techniques, which are thankfully no longer employed!

Neil was at the time an apprentice to the Aeronautical Quality Assurance Directorate, a branch of the Ministry of Defence responsible for the quality of design and manufacture of all military aircraft both fixed wing and helicopters. Neil was employed by this branch of M.O.D. until the TR business was started in 1981, initially being called TR Spares South West.

This background in the aircraft industry laid the groundwork for many of the modifications that Revington TR have developed for the TR range

Although now well known for their modified parts, Revington TR started as standard parts suppliers, a section of the business, which is now as healthy as ever, covering over 50,000 part numbers. Our stock of new parts is vast and has to be seen to be believed. Never assume a part is unavailable, always ask. We hope you will be surprised.

Revington TR is situated in the heart of the Somerset levels in the South West of England - eleven miles from Taunton and six miles from Bridgwater and the M5 Motorway.

We occupy a three-acre ex-farm site where the farm buildings have been converted to stores and workshops. More recently we have converted a collection of barns across the road from Home Farm where the Parts Department has now moved, called Thorngrove Barns.
